- Most notable on the list of district celebrations was the Commencement Ceremony for the Class of 2018, held on June 23. Sixty-five seniors graduated having accomplished a great deal during their 13 years with us and with exciting plans for the future.
- Five of our spring varsity athletic teams recently qualified for the NYS Scholar Athlete Team Award. This award is earned by teams with a collective team average of 90% or above. C-S teams recognized were baseball, softball, girls’ track and field, boys’ track and field and tennis.
- The C-S Marching Band placed first at the Colonial Days Parade in June.
- The C-S drama program received several awards at the Rochester Stars of Tomorrow ceremony for their production of *Sister Act* including: Outstanding Musical, Outstanding Acting Ensemble, Outstanding Production Crew, Outstanding Dance Ensemble, Outstanding Singing Ensemble and Outstanding Supporting Actress: Giavanna Reed.

I am also pleased to share with the community that C-S was named as a *US News and World Report* Bronze Medal High School for the third consecutive year. C-S was so honored because our students performed at a statistically higher level on state tests and regents exams than similar students across New York State. We also have a very high graduation rate-90% on the most recent New York State School Report Card. Thanks go out to our parents who support their children’s education and to the entire C-S community for your support of our District.

And now we look forward to the 2018-19 School Year. Our goal, as we anticipate the coming school year, continues to be to provide the programs and opportunities for all students which will enable them

to be successful, contributing citizens, once they bid the halls of C-S good-bye...our parting wish for the Class of 2018!
